A Note from Worship & Music

Greek philosopher Heraclitus is said to have been the first to say, "The only constant is change." We have changes in our weather, in the seasons, in our lives and families and in the life of the church. A major change is the arrival of our shepherd, Pastor Sprowls, who thankfully came as our Interim Pastor!

We should expect seasonal changes in our Sunday liturgy. However, we at CLC have not deviated from two settings of the liturgy that date back to the 1978 *Lutheran Book of Worship*.

Pastor has already brought us up to date on some of our liturgy. The Christmas, Epiphany, and Easter seasons are festive times in the church, times when it is generally accepted to omit the confession in favor of other means of entering into worship. When Lent arrives, we will be using an order for confession as well as other elements (e.g., Kyrie, Nunc dimittis, etc.) appropriate to this penitential season.

In addition to providing more frequent explanations of changes in the liturgy, Pastor will be offering Worship 101 on Sundays in Lent. We hope you'll be eager to learn more about the roots of Christian worship and the riches of the liturgy. As in recent times, Director of Music Nicole Nicholson and Pastor will be creating video messages to be published each Wednesday during Lent. We trust you'll look forward to these brief meditations on scripture and music.

2025 Easter Flower Memorials

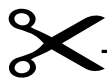
Dear Friends,

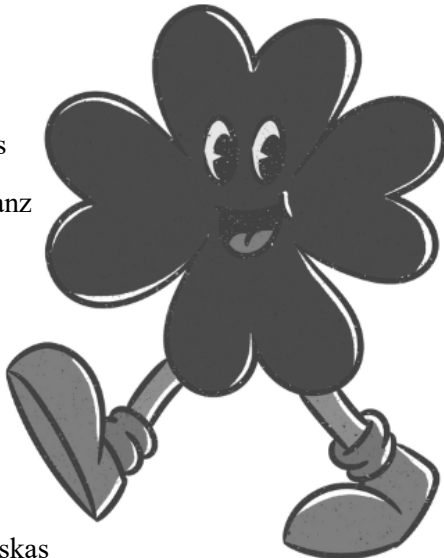

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Outreach Updates

- Special collections continue to be received through the month of February for Lutheran Disaster Response re: the Southern California wildfires. We are grateful to the Thrift Shop for their donation of proceeds from one week's sales to this effort. Council will research ways that we may also help LDR in their continuing relief efforts in North Carolina, which may last months or years.
- WELCA is collecting items for Personal Care Kits through the end of February. A collection box will be near the sanctuary entrance. Kits will be assembled at their March meeting.
- Jeri Hallgren continues to organize the delivery of altar flowers to the shut-ins. Thank you for your hard work!

General Worship Updates

- Christmas/Epiphany Cycle: It was noted that, in keeping with common practice, the Order for Confession and Forgiveness is being omitted during the festive Christmas/Epiphany cycle.
- Ash Wednesday worship service will be held on March 5th at 7PM. The liturgy will be updated during the Lenten season, in keeping with common ELCA practice. Nothing wholly unfamiliar will be introduced to the congregation.
- Lenten devotions will be sent out via email every Wednesday, organized by Nicole and Pastor.
- The Holy Week worship schedule is as follows: Palm Sunday, 9AM; Maundy Thursday, 7PM; Good Friday, 7PM; Easter Sunday, 9AM and 11AM.
- Easter flowers have been ordered from Borella Nursery and will be delivered on Good Friday.

Music Ministry Updates

- The Bell Choir is scheduled to play on February 16th and March 1st. Necessary repairs were made to a few malfunctioning instruments.
- Planning continues for the development of a children's choir, which will either be named as such or called the Jubilation Choir. More updates to follow.
- We are transitioning to singing during the Communion hymn as a way to enhance congregational repertoire and exposure to important hymns.

- Potential Easter liturgies are under development and review.

Christian Education Updates

- Pastor will be meeting with Roxanne to discuss changes to Confirmation instruction. She will be taking over the leadership role previously shared by Nicole and Della.
- Pastor will be offering First Communion instruction this Spring to all who are interested. Dylan Kemnah is scheduled to receive First Communion this year (date to be confirmed by his family).
- Thank you to Jeri Hallgren and Barbara Rath for collecting over 1500 eggs for this year's Easter Egg Hunts. Volunteers to fill them are welcome. More details to follow.

Nursery Updates

- Registration for the 2025-2026 school year is open. 77 children are currently enrolled and limited spots remain.
- Registration for the 2025 Summer Program begins next month. We anticipate another full enrollment.
- The Nursery School will participate in an LSA Day celebration during worship service on March 2nd.
- Picture Day will be held on March 3rd and 4th.

THRIFT SHOP

Our thrift shop is open on Fridays, 9AM-3PM, and the first Saturday of each month, 10AM-2PM. **The next Thrift Shop Saturday will be held on March 1st.**

For your convenience, a donation shed is available for your use outside of Thrift Shop hours. **Please be sure to place your donations in the shed, not outside of it, as we cannot guarantee they will be brought inside right away.** If you are making a sizeable donation (quantity or very large items), please call the Church office ahead of time. **We are not able to accept donations of books, cribs, or mattresses at this time.** If you are unsure of whether we



can accept an item, please call the Church office to be connected with a Thrift Shop coordinator. Thank you!

CHRISTIAN OUTREACH

Homebound Communion: Did you know that we offer Communion for the homebound? Due to a temporary illness or injury or a long-term situation, this option is available to you. If you or a loved one is interested in receiving Communion at home or at a care facility, please contact the Church office.

SoCal Wildfire Relief: Monetary donations are currently being collected on behalf of Lutheran Disaster Response. Your donation will be used to provide front-line *and* long-term support for those impacted by the wildfires. Donation envelopes are available in the Sanctuary. If you would like to mail in a donation, please be sure to designate it appropriately for SoCal Wildfire Relief.

Lutheran World Relief Personal Care Kits: Thank you to all who contributed needed items to the LWR Personal Care Kits. The kits will be assembled during the March WELCA meeting.

THRIVENT FINANCIAL

To Members of the Congregation: On March 5th, WELCA and Thrivent plan to assemble and ship personal care kits for Lutheran World Relief to help people who are victims of natural disasters or political upheaval. LWR has been working for over 80 years to help our neighbors in times of extreme need. Tens of thousands of people around the country have taken part in the program to assemble kits of essential items needed by our neighbors both near and far. LWR coordinates with multiple organizations responding at the local level when communities in the U.S. are affected by disasters like hurricanes, tornadoes, flood and wildfires. We are looking for members of the congregation to donate bath towels (preferably dark colors), bath-size soap bars, toothbrushes, wide-tooth combs, and nail clippers. **We especially need bath towels.** In the past we've found light-weight towels at Walmart for between \$2-\$3. Donated items can be left in the box in the loggia. You can also donate money for this project. Please send checks payable to WELCA to the church office. We are grateful to **Thrivent** for their allocation of \$250 for this worthwhile project. Thank you for any help you can give.
