Easter? Already?

It's an odd feeling to bring you Easter greetings when we're approaching the Fourth Sunday in Lent. And yet, even the Sundays in Lent are "little Easters," that include references to the Easter readings. "On the third day he rose again," we affirm in the Nicene Creed. "He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again," we declare in the words of the Apostles' Creed. "Christ has died, Christ is risen," we declare during the eucharistic prayer. When we receive the dismissal, it is as if we are the women at the tomb witnessing to the others, urging them to go in peace and be "little Christs" to one another.

Easter is indeed the most joyous season of the Christian year. After 40 days of Lenten austerity with its focus on prayer, fasting, and acts of charity, we will be more than ready for Easter's 50 days of rejoicing! As we move in and through this Lent toward the cross and empty tomb – and beyond – here are a few congregational guideposts along the way:

- During the 5 Sundays of Lent, you are invited to participate in Worship 101, a class with discussion of the basic elements of Lutheran liturgical worship.
- The liturgies of Holy Week and Easter are under development. As these dates near, you'll be invited to explore opportunities to participate in leading these deeply meaningful liturgies.
- On Palm Sunday after worship, we will offer an orientation session for new members who will be received during worship on Easter Sunday.
- On April 27, we'll have a decidedly kid-friendly liturgy. What is often considered "low Sunday" will be an opportunity to celebrate holy humor Sunday, in keeping with a long-standing tradition of *Risus paschalis*, Easter laughter.
- Following the synod assembly on May 2 and 3, we will welcome my dear friend and Divinity School classmate, the Rev. Kenneth Davis, as our guest preacher. In addition to being a wonderful pastor, he moonlights as Spider-Man, so will be making an appearance at the nursery school in character.
- Further into May, I'll be offering Holy Communion instruction for all who want to prepare to receive their 1st Communion and all who would like a refresher on the Sacrament. I very much enjoy teaching this faith milestone. If you attend, come ready to learn and to have fun!

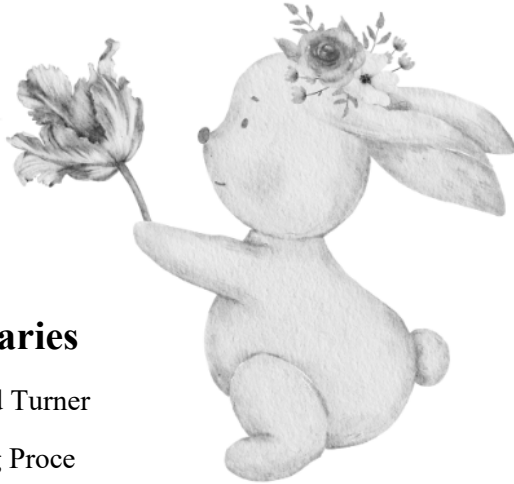

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Outreach Updates

- **Easter Cards:** Thank you to Regina C., who will once again send out Easter cards to our shut-ins.
- **Flower Deliveries:** Jeri H. will collaborate with the Church office to arrange the Easter flower deliveries.

General Worship Updates

- **Order of Worship:** The order of worship has now switched to reflect the somberness of the Lenten season. It will switch again once we have entered the joyous Easter season.
- **Lenten devotions** continue to be sent out via email every Wednesday, organized by Nicole and Pastor.
- The **Holy Week worship schedule** is as follows: Palm Sunday, 9AM; Maundy Thursday, 7PM; Good Friday, 7PM; Easter Sunday, 9AM and 11AM.
- All **Holy Week materials** have been ordered.
- **Other Holy Week Needs:**
 - A "spry" volunteer to get on a ladder to change the vestments on the cross and Christus Rex in the sanctuary for Good Friday and Easter.
 - We need to check the condition of the Tenebrae candles to see whether or not they can be reused or need to be replaced.
 - Claudia & John will need assistance stripping the altar. Pastor Sprowls suggests that the heavy frontal be removed prior to Maundy Thursday so that it doesn't pose difficulties when the altar is being stripped.
- **Communion Cards:** In order to maintain an accurate membership roll, all attendees at the Easter worship services will be asked to fill out a Communion card.

Music Ministry Updates

- As we enter the liturgical season of Lent, we are pleased to introduce new Service Music that reflects this sacred time of reflection. In addition, Nicole will be selecting new Service Music for the Easter Season in order to expand our musical repertoire and introduce the congregation to some of the more recent settings.
- Our two enthusiastic "Cherubs," Gavin and Zoe, are eager to sing again. Nicole is working on selecting an appropriate song for Lent that is both meaningful and easy for them to learn.
- Bell Choir & Adult Choir will continue their weekly rehearsals on Wednesdays at 7PM and 8PM respectively. Looking ahead to Easter, we hope to



incorporate more voices into the Easter services and encourage more students to sing on Easter Sunday.

direct them online at Thrivent.com. If you don't do this by **March 31st**, you will lose the opportunity to direct Thrivent's money to a cause you believe in.

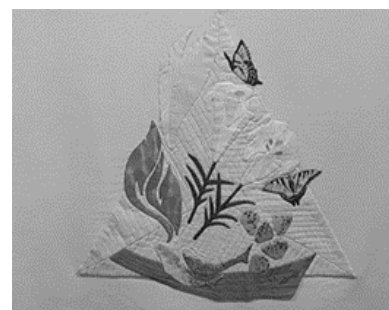

CLC HISTORY



One timeless feature of our Easter celebration is the altar frontal. Designed by Susan Beck, the frontal was created at the request of the Geestmann family, as a memorial to Peter Geestmann. The design features the following:

The Boat: *Jesus is our calm in the storm.* The boat symbolizes Christ's Church. **The music staff** on the boat alludes to the hymn, "A Mighty Fortress is Our God."

Loaves and Fishes: *Jesus is our spiritual nourishment.* The loaves and fishes allude to the Gospel story of Jesus feeding a crowd of 5,000.

Butterflies: *Jesus will return.* The butterflies symbolize the Resurrection.

Calla Lilly with Flame: *The Holy Spirit will fill God's chosen people.* Another symbol of the Resurrection, the Calla Lilly transitions into the flame of Pentecost. The flames are shaped into a "P" and "G," for Peter Geestmann.

In addition to these adornments, we will continue our tradition of filling the church with beautiful **Easter flowers** as memorials to our loved ones. Please see the form included in the Spire for an Easter flower memorial form. Please submit your memorials by **Tuesday, April 15th**.
